2nd Northwest Annual Research Conference, 2023 20 – 21 October 2023

The 2nd annual two-day international multidisciplinary conference was held at Northwest School of Medicine, Peshawar on 20 and 21 October 2023. The theme of the conference was "From Bench to Bedside". More than 1000 participants attended the event where faculty members, students and health professionals presented 200 research papers in Medicine & Allied, Surgery & Allied, Pediatrics & Obstetrics and Basic Sciences.

In his inaugural address the Principal Professor Noor UI Iman, apprised the participants about the importance of the conference for academic advancement, exchange of ideas for future research collaboration and development. He added the activity enhanced the careers of young researchers and experts alike.

The Chief Guest Prof. Dr. Tariq Hashim Khan, Chairman Allied Health Limited formally inaugurated the conference. He said North West School of Medicine is the only medical college in Pakistan that is a member of G4 Alliance comprising over 170 nations which aims to bridge public health gaps arising from lack of safe, affordable,
